

The Gatehouse was used in the old days as a detention centre. The place was also called «sitting detention» because the ceiling was so low that it was not possible to stand. The commander passed judgement on prisoners, and put them on bread and water for 3 days. The commander then sent in the Bible, in the hope that the prisoners would convert and come to their senses. You can see the letters KAP in the gateway. These are the initials of Karl Albert Passau; the first commander at this fortress.


